

Class Charter Year 4

Article 28: Every child has the right to an education

Children – Work sensibly without distracting others. Look after equipment. Be supportive of each other's learning.

Adult – provide equipment for learning, support children, ensure children feel safe and secure

Article 2 : The Convention applies to everyone; whatever race, religion or ability

Children/ adults– Treat other people as we want to be treated

Article 12 : Every child has the right to have a say in all matters affecting them

Child: Choose language carefully not to be overpowering e.g. 'That's interesting, I think differently...'. Listen to each other, even if you don't agree.

Adults: Provide opportunities for 'pupil voice'/ class representatives

Article 15 : Every child has the right to meet with other children and join groups

Children – Communicate with each other e.g. 'I was going to play with someone else today, can we play tomorrow?'. 'It upsets me when you say '....''

Don't hurt each other's feelings

Adults – Supporting getting children to know each other e.g. playground games. Provide opportunities for going to clubs.

Article 16: Every child has the right to privacy

Children – Don't poke your nose into others' business. Bathroom privacy – keep eyes to yourself! Respect others wanting privacy (they don't need to be with you all the time).

Adults – provide consequences/ warnings
