<p><u>Maths</u> Multiplication and division Efficient formal written methods to multiply numbers with up to 4 digits by 2 digits and divide 4 digits by 1 digit, including dealing with remainders. Number: Fractions Compare and order fractions whose denominators are multiples of the same number. Identify, name and write equivalent fractions of a given fraction, represented visually including tenths and hundredths. Recognise mixed numbers and improper fractions and convert from one form to the other and write mathematical statements >1 as a mixed number [for example $2/5 + 4/5 = 6/5 = 1 \frac{1}{5}$].
