Maths <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify one more and one less than a given number • Use and understand vocabulary such as: equal to, more than, less than, most and least • Count to and across 10, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number • Count, read and write numbers from 1 to 10 in numerals and words • Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations • Add and subtract numbers to 10, including 0 and recognise those number bonds that make 10 • Sort objects into groups • Recognise and name 2D and 3D shapes • Describe the properties of 2D and 3D shapes 	Homework <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Regular reading and record keeping in the Reading Diary • Use the word lists in your Reading Diary as well as Spelling Shed online for practising spellings at home • Practising phonics sounds and “alien” words • Practising cursive handwriting using the cursive handwriting PowerPoint on the Year 1 web page • Online Purple Mash activities if set • Any other internet-based home learning activities as suggested via our class page on the school website • Take part in the Autumn Term Reading Challenge
