English <u>Writing units will be:</u> The Explorer: Non-chronological report The Boat: 1 st person recount Throughout these units, the children will be developing their use of language to create different effects and applying grammar skills.	Your child will also be taking part in these activities on the following days: PE – Monday (Netball/Quidditch) and Friday (Gymnastics/Dance). Maths Number: Multiplication and division Efficient formal written methods to multiply numbers with up to 4 digits by 2 digits and divide 4 digits by 1 digit, including dealing with remainders. Number: Fractions Compare and order fractions whose denominators are multiples of the same number. Identify, name and write equivalent fractions of a given fraction, represented visually including tenths and hundredths. Recognise mixed numbers and improper fractions and convert from one form to the other and write mathematical statements >1 as a mixed number [for example $2/5 + 4/5 = 6/5 = 1 \frac{1}{5}$]. Add fractions with the same denominator and denominators that are multiples of the same number.
