Main areas of study <u>English</u> Writing units will include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Writing unit based on the book Rumblestar • Persuasive writing about animals in captivity Writing units will be cover a variety of different styles and genres such as narrative, non-fiction texts and descriptive writing. Through all of these, the children will be developing their sentence structure, as well as their understanding of the structure of different genres. <u>Maths</u> Direction Describe positions on a 2D grid as coordinates in the first quadrant. Describe movements between positions as translations of a given unit to the left/ right and up/ down. Plot specified points and draw sides to complete a given polygon. Statitics Interpreting charts and graphs	Shape Identify acute and obtuse angles and compare and order angles up to two right angles by size. Compare and classify geometric shapes, including quadrilaterals and triangles, based on their properties and sizes. Identify lines of symmetry in 2-D shapes presented in different orientations. Complete a simple symmetric figure with respect to a specific line of symmetry.
