

Reading

Word Reading

- Read alternative sounds for graphemes and use the skill of blending to read unknown words
- Read the Year 2 common exception words
- Read words containing common suffixes
- Read words of 2 or more syllables

Comprehension

- Listen to, discuss and express views on a wide range of literature
- Recognise simple recurring language in stories and poetry
- Discuss and clarify the meaning of new words
- Discuss their favourite words and phrases (Reading Tools)
- Recount main events and how items of information are related (sequencing)
- Be introduced to non-fiction books which are structured in different ways
- Make inferences and predict what may happen next



Writing

Spelling & Handwriting

- Spell words containing all phonic sounds taught, as well as the Year 2 common exception words
- Form capital letters and digits of the correct size and orientation
- Form lowercase letters of the correct size relative to one and other

Composition

- Punctuate sentences correctly with capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to form statements, questions, exclamations and commands
- Use commas for lists
- Use apostrophes for contracted forms and possession (singular)
- Use expanded noun phrases
- Use the present and past tense correctly
- Use subordination (when, if, that, because) and co-ordination (or, and, but) to link ideas
- Plan or say out loud what I want to write before writing
- Write a sequence of sentences to form a simple text
- Make simple additions, revisions and corrections by re-reading and reading aloud
- Read my writing with appropriate intonation to make meaning clear



Maths

- Compare and order numbers up to 100 and use $<$ $>$ $=$
- Read and write all numbers to 100 in digits & words
- Recognise place value of any 2-digit number
- Count in steps of 2, 3 & 5 from zero and in 10s from any number (forwards and backwards)
- Recall and use multiplication & division facts for 2, 5 & 10 tables
- Recall and use $+$ / $-$ facts to 20 fluently
- Derive and use related facts to 100
- Add & subtract: 2-digit number & ones; 2-digit number & tens; two 2-digit numbers; three 1-digit nos
- Recognise and use inverse ($+$ / $-$)
- Calculate and write multiplication & division calculations using multiplication tables
- Recognise, find, name and write $\frac{1}{3}$; $\frac{1}{4}$; $\frac{2}{4}$; $\frac{3}{4}$
- Write and recognise equivalence of simple fractions
- Tell time to five minutes, including quarter past/to
