Principle Areas of Study English Writing units will be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Narrative – building our story-telling skills • Traditional tales • Acrostic poems for Harvest Phonics <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smart Kids: The Code – Consolidation of previous learning and introduction of Phase 5 sounds 	Your child will also be taking part in these activities on the following days: PE – Monday and Wednesday Fundamental Movement Skills, Gymnastics and Yoga <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Please ensure correct kit is worn to school on these days, no jewellery is worn, and long hair is tied back. Forest School – (3 sessions) Wednesdays – 10th, 17th & 24th September <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Please wear warm clothes that you don't mind getting dirty, with wellies, waterproof trousers and a coat.
Maths <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify one more and one less than a given number • Use and understand vocabulary such as: equal to, more than / greater than, less than, most and least, smallest and greatest • Count to and across 10, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number • Count, read and write numbers from 1 to 10 in numerals and words • Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations • Add and subtract numbers to 10 including 0 and recognise those number bonds that make 10 • Count objects and sort them into groups according to different criteria • Recognise and understand the value of numbers to 10 including 0 	Home Learning <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Regular reading and record keeping in the Reading Diary, plus try the Autumn Reading Challenge • Extra reading through Serial Mash or Oxford Owl is also available • Phonics practise using the sounds and tricky words found in the Reading Diary and attached to the bottom of the Year 1 web page alongside Phonics "Alien" word practise • Purple Mash or any other Internet-based home learning activities suggested via the class page on the school website • Use the 'Out and About' maths cards attached to the parents' area of the school website for fun ways to use maths in everyday situations • Noting how your everyday environment alters with the changing seasons • Practise number recognition using the flashcards attached to the bottom of the Year 1 web page
