Langrish School Privacy Notice for Governors

The categories of governance information that we process include:

- Personal identifiers, contacts and characteristics (such as name, date of birth, contact details and post code)
- Governance details (such as role, start and end dates and governor ID)

Why we collect and use Governance information

We use the data listed above to:

- a) Establish and maintain effective governance
- b) Meet statutory obligations for publishing and sharing governor details
- c) Facilitate safe recruitment, as part of our safeguarding obligations towards pupils
- d) Undertake equalities monitoring
- e) Ensure that appropriate access arrangements can be provided for volunteers who require them
- f) Make sure our information and communication systems, equipment and facilities (e.g. school computers) are used appropriately, legally and safely

If you fail to provide certain information when requested, we may not be able to perform the contract we have entered into with you, or we may be prevented from complying with our legal obligations (such as to ensure the health and safety of our workers and pupils).

We will only use your personal information for the purposes for which we have collected it, unless we reasonably consider that we need to use it for another reason and that reason is compatible with the original purpose. If we need to use your personal information for an unrelated purpose, we will notify you and explain the legal basis which allows us to do so.

Please note that we may process your personal information without your knowledge or consent in compliance with the above rules where this is required or permitted by law.

Use of your personal data for filtering and monitoring purposes

While you're in our school, we may monitor your use of our information and communication systems, equipment and facilities (e.g. school computers). We do this so that we can:

- Comply with health and safety and other legal obligations
- Comply with our policies and our legal obligations
- Keep our network and devices safe from unauthorised access, and prevent malicious software from harming our network

Collecting governance information

We collect personal information via Governor Services application forms and requests for DBS checks.

Governance data is essential for the school's operational use. Whilst the majority of personal information you provide to us is mandatory, some of it may be requested on a voluntary basis. In order to comply with GDPR,

we will inform you at the point of collection, whether you are required to provide certain information to us or if you have a choice in this.

Most of the data we hold about you will come from you, but we may also hold data about you from:

- Local authorities
- Government departments or agencies
- Police forces, courts or tribunals
- Other schools or trusts

Storing governance information

We hold data securely for the set amount of time shown in our data retention schedule. We will dispose of your personal data securely when we no longer need it.

Who we share governance information with

We routinely share this information with:

- Our local authority (where applicable)
- The Department of Education (DfE)

Why we share governance information

We do not share information about individuals in governance roles with anyone without consent unless the law and our policies allow us to do so

Local Authority

We are required to share information about our governors with our local authority (LA) under section 538 of the Education Act 1996.

Department for Education

The Department for Education (DfE) collects personal data from educational settings and local authorities. We are required to share information about individuals in governance roles with the Department for Education (DfE) under section 538 of the Education Act 1996.

Requesting access to your personal data

Under data protection legislation, you have the right to request access to information about you that we hold. To make a request for your personal information contact Mrs Helen Greenwood – Data Protection Officer in writing via the School Office.

You also have the right to:

- To ask us for access to information about you that we hold
- To have your personal data rectified, if it is inaccurate or incomplete
- To request the deletion or removal of personal data where there is no compelling reason for its continued processing
- To restrict our processing of your personal data (i.e. permitting its storage but no further processing)

- To object to direct marketing (including profiling) and processing for the purposes of scientific/historic research and statistics
- Not to be subject to decisions based purely on automated processing where it produces a legal or similarly significant effect on you

How Government uses your data

The governance data that we lawfully share with the DfE via GIAS:

- Will increase the transparency of governance arrangements
- Will enable maintained schools and academy trusts and the department to identify more quickly and accurately individuals who are involved in governance and who govern in more than one context
- Allows the department to be able to uniquely identify an individual and in a small number of cases conduct checks to confirm their suitability for this important and influential role

Data collection requirements

Note: Some of these personal data items are not publically available and are encrypted within the GIAS system. Access is restricted to a small number of DfE staff who need to see it in order to fulfil department, unless the law allows it.

How to find out what personal information DfE hold about you

Under the terms of the Data Protection Act 2018, you're entitled to ask the Department:

- If they are processing your personal data
- For a description of the data they hold about you
- The reasons they're holding it and any recipient it may be disclosed to
- For a copy of your personal data and any details of its source
